



**THE FISHERIES (QUOTA MANAGEMENT AREAS, TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCHES, AND CATCH HISTORIES) NOTICE 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 8**

PURSUANT to section 280B of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, acting after allowing for the matters specified in section 280 of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.

**2. Total allowable commercial catch for hoki decreased**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item A of the item relating to hoki, and substituting the following item:

“A.	Auckland (East), Auckland (West), Central (East), Central (Egmont), Challenger/Central (Plateau), South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise), Southland, and Sub-Antarctic combined	1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9	201 877”.

**3. Total allowable commercial catch for orange roughy decreased**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting items F and G of the item relating to orange roughy (as substituted by clause 3 of the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the following items:

**4. Total allowable commercial catch for red cod decreased**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item D of the item relating to red cod, and substituting the following item:

“D.	South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise) Southland and Sub-Antarctic combined	3, 4, 5, and 6	12 024.100”.

**5. Total allowable commercial catch for blue warehou decreased**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item E of the item relating to blue warehou, and substituting the following item:

“E.	South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise), Southland, and Sub-Antarctic combined	3, 4, 5, and 6	2455.500”.

**6. Revocation**—Clause 3 of the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 7 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice, which comes into force on 1 October 1990, amends the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986 to reduce the total allowable commercial catch for certain species as follows:

- (i) The total allowable commercial catch for hoki in the Auckland (East), Auckland (West), Central (East), Central (Egmont), Challenger/Central (Plateau), South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise), Southland and Sub-Antarctic combined area is reduced to 201 877 greenweight tonnes.
- (ii) The total allowable commercial catch for orange roughy in the Challenger (North) area (Area 7A) is reduced to 1900 greenweight tonnes.
- (iii) The total allowable commercial catch for orange roughy in the Combined South-East, Southland and Sub-Antarctic area (Areas 3B, 4, 5A, and 6) is reduced to 23 787 greenweight tonnes.
- (iv) The total allowable commercial catch for red cod in the South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise), Southland and Sub-Antarctic areas combined is reduced to 12 024.1 greenweight tonnes. This reduction will be met in part by the cancellation of Crown quota as required by section 280n of the Fisheries Act 1983.
- (v) The total allowable commercial catch for blue warehou in the South-East (Coast), South-East (Chatham Rise), Southland and Sub-Antarctic areas combined is reduced to 2455.5 greenweight tonnes.
