



**THE FISHERIES (JACK MACKEREL QUOTA MANAGEMENT
AREAS, TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCHES, AND CATCH
HISTORIES) NOTICE 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 28B of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

—

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Jack Mackerel Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Jack Mackerel Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1996.

2. Interpretation—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking clause 2, and substituting the following clause:

“2. In this notice—

“The Act’ means the Fisheries Act 1983:

“‘Challenger, Central (Egmont), Auckland (West) Area’ means all New Zealand fisheries waters in Fishery Management Area 7—Challenger/Central (Plateau), Fishery Management Area 8—Central (Egmont), and Fishery Management Area 9—Auckland (West) as defined in Part I of the First Schedule to the Fisheries Act 1996:

“‘Jack mackerel’ means the fish of which the scientific name is *Trachurus spp.*:

“‘Kermadec Area’ means all New Zealand fisheries waters in Fishery Management Area 10—Kermadec as defined in Part I of the First Schedule to the Fisheries Act 1996.”

3. Amendment to Schedule—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the word “Part”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 October 1996, amends the Fisheries (Jack Mackerel Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987 by altering the definitions of the “Challenger, Central (Egmont), Auckland (West) Area” and the “Kermadec Area”. The definitions now refer to the Fishery Management Areas in the Fisheries Act 1996.
