THE FENCING (HALF-COST) ORDER 1947

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 41 of the Fencing Act, 1908, as amended by section 5 of the Fencing Amendment Act, 1922, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Fencing (Half-cost) Order 1947.
- 2. The Order in Council fixing the maximum price payable in respect of the half-cost of erecting certain kinds of fences made on the 9th day of April, 1923,* is hereby revoked.
- 3. The maximum prices payable under the Fencing Act, 1908, in respect of the half-cost of erecting non-rabbit-proof fences of the kinds described in clauses 1 to 5 (inclusive) of Part I of the Second Schedule to the said Act, are hereby fixed as follows:—
 - (a) A fence of the kind described in clause 1 .. 130s. per chain.
 - (b) A fence of the kind described in clause 2 .. 110s. per chain.
 - (c) A fence of the kind described in clause 3 .. 150s. per chain.
 - (d) A fence of the kind described in clause 4 . . 55s. per chain.
 - (e) A fence of the kind described in clause 5 ..47s. 6d. per chain.
