

# THE FOREST PRODUCE IMPORT AND EXPORT REGULATIONS 1966, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1967

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1966\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 10th day of July 1967.
- 2. New Third Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule, and substituting the Third Schedule as set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

### SCHEDULE

#### NEW THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE FOREST PRODUCE IMPORT AND **EXPORT REGULATIONS 1966**

### "THIRD SCHEDULE

Reg. 10 (1), 27 Costs of Inspecting Forest Produce

THE costs of inspecting forest produce imported into or exported from New Zealand shall be calculated at the rate of 3 cents for each 100 superficial or board feet, except that for forest produce in the form of box shooks the cost shall be calculated at the rate of 1.5 cents for each 100 superficial or board feet, and for forest produce exported in log form the cost shall be calculated at the rate of 12.5 cents per 100 cubic feet or 1.25 cents per 100 feet Haakon Dahl measure.

Costs of Storing Forest Produce Reg. 18 (2)

The cost of storing forest produce shall be calculated at the rate of 5 cents per day for each 100 superficial or board feet or 60 cents per day for each 100 cubic feet."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revise the Third Schedule to the principal regulations relating to the costs for inspecting and storing forest produce so as to express the rates in decimal currency as from the time of its introduction.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.
