PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1978.

2. Costs of inspecting forest produce—The Third Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by omitting the words “exported in log form”, and substituting the words “in round form”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations to provide for costs of inspection of forest produce in round form, whether imported or exported.
