PURSUANT to section 72 of the Forests Act 1949, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Inspection costs in respect of LCL bulk cargo containers reduced—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 (1) of the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations

1989, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "3.33" where it occurs opposite clause 1 (b) (ii), and substituting the expression "2.90".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Forest Produce Import and Export Regulations 1989 by reducing from \$3.30 to \$2.90 per revenue tonne the cost of inspecting forest produce in an LCL bulk cargo container.
