

# THE FISHERIES (SQUID QUOTA MANAGEMENT AREAS, TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCHES, AND CATCH HISTORIES) NOTICE 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, acting after consultation with the Fishing Industry Board, and after allowing for the matters referred to in section 28D of that Act, hereby gives the following notice.

#### NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Squid Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Squid Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
  - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1990.
- **2. Schedule substituted**—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 October 1990, amends the Fisheries (Squid Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1987 to decrease the total allowable commercial catch for squid as follows:

- (i) The total allowable commercial catch for squid in the Southern Islands Area is decreased from 32,333 tonnes to 30,190.1 tonnes.
- (ii) The total allowable commercial catch for squid in all other New Zealand Fisheries waters (except part of the Auckland fishery management area) is decreased from 57,705 tonnes to 46,087.2 tonnes for jigging, and from 30,962 tonnes to 42,284 tonnes for all methods.

These decreases reflect the cancellation by the Crown of quota that it holds for squid in those areas.
