

THE FISHERIES (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 24

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of June 1976

Present: The Hon. J. B. Gordon presiding in Council

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 24, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Use of Danish seine net by more than 1 vessel—Regulation 69 (3) (as inserted by regulation 5 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 20) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "1976", and substituting the expression "1977".
- 3. Prohibited waters for use of Danish seine net—Regulation 72 (10) (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 19, and amended by regulation 6 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 20) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression "1976", and substituting the expression "1977".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950. The effect is to extend, for a further year, the provisions relating to Danish seining by more than 1 vessel, and to Danish seining in the Hauraki Gulf.
