THE FISHERIES (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Regulation 72 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (8), and substituting the following heading and subclause:

"Whangarei

"(8) The waters of the sea lying within three nautical miles of high-water mark of that portion of the mainland lying between the southernmost point of Busby Head, near Whangarei Heads, and the north-western point of Mackenzie Cove."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations amend the description of the waters of the Whangarei Harbour and adjacent waters in which Danish seining is prohibited. The effect of the amendment is that Danish seining is prohibited in the same waters as those in which trawling is prohibited under regulation 80 (8) of the principal regulations.
