HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 40, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1983.

2. Trawl nets—Regulation 75 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 7 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 38) is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (7), after the words “in area E”, the words “or in that part of Area F south of latitude 48°30.0' South”.

3. Third Schedule to principal regulations amended—The Third Schedule to the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 4 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 33), is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from the description of Fisheries Management Area E the words “a line commencing from a point 48°30.0' South and 161°34.5' East;”, and substituting the words “a line commencing in the west at a point on the outer limit of the exclusive economic zone at the 49°00.0' South parallel of latitude; and then proceeding in an easterly direction to a point 49°00.0' South and 169°00.0' East; and then proceeding in a northerly direction to a point 48°30.0' South and 169°00.0' East;”.
- (b) By omitting from the description of Fisheries Management Area F the words “and then proceeding in a southerly direction along the outer limits of the exclusive economic zone to latitude 48°30.0' South;”, and substituting the words “and then proceeding in a southerly direction along the outer limits of the exclusive economic zone to latitude 49°00.0' South; and then proceeding in an easterly direction to a point 49°00.0' South and 169°00.0' East; and then proceeding in a northerly direction to a point 48°30.0' South and 169°00.0' East;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make minor changes to the boundary description of Fisheries Management Area E and consequential changes to the description of Area F.

The present northern limit for the use of 60 mm trawl net mesh remains at latitude 48°30.0' South—see reg. 2.
