

## THE FERTILISERS (FEES) REGULATIONS 1961

# COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of June 1961

### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Fertilisers Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Fertilisers (Fees) Regulations 1961.
  - 2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—
    "The Act" means the Fertilisers Act 1960:

Expressions defined in the Act have the meanings so defined.

3. (1) The fees payable by a proprietor for the registration of fertilisers in any period of registration shall be as follows:

Where the number of fertilisers registered by the £ s. d. proprietor does not exceed 10 ...... 5 0 0 Where the number of fertilisers registered by the proprietor exceeds 10, for each fertiliser registered ..... 0 10 0

Provided that the fees payable by any proprietor in any period of registration for the registration of fertilisers shall not exceed £25.

- (2) The Director-General shall not issue a certificate of registration in respect of any fertiliser until he has received from the proprietor of that fertiliser the fees which that proprietor is required to pay under subclause (1) of this regulation.
- 4. The fee payable by the purchaser of any fertiliser to an Inspector under subsection (2) of section 27 of the Act for the taking by the Inspector of a sample of the fertiliser shall be £5.
- 5. The fee payable by the vendor of any fertiliser under subsection (3) of section 26 or subsection (7) of section 27 of the Act for a copy of a certificate of analysis shall be, in each case, £2.

- 6. All fees received under these regulations shall be paid into the Public Account to the credit of the Consolidated Fund.
- 7. Clause 7 of the Fertilisers Regulations 1928\* and the Fertilisers Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 1†, are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE
