ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 36 of the Fertilisers Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fertilisers Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fertilisers Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fineness of grinding—Regulation 32 (b) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “80 percent”, the words “(or, in the case of Sechura phosphate rock, 60 percent)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that the fineness of grinding of Sechura phosphate rock (from Peru) used as a fertiliser need not be finer than to allow 60 percent by weight to pass through a N.Z. Standard Sieve No. 100.
