

## THE FILMS REGULATIONS 1984, AMENDMENT NO. 8

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 6th day of June 1989

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 75 of the Films Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## **REGULATIONS**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Films Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Films Regulations 1984\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Films Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **3. Revocation**—Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Films Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees payable for various matters under the Films Act 1983. The increases reflect the increase in the rate of goods and services tax from 10 percent to 12.5 percent.

All of the fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
