

THE FOOD REGULATIONS 1984, AMENDMENT NO. 7

PURSUANT to section 42 of the Food Act 1981, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Food Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Food Regulations 1984*.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1993.
- 2. Incidental constituents—(1) Regulation 1 (3) of the Food Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 5 is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (k).

"(3A) Regulation 106 (4) of these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1994."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 January 1993, delay, until 1 January 1994, the coming into force of regulation 106 (4) of the Food Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 5. Regulation 106 (4), which was to have come into force on 1 January 1993, amended the second table to regulation 257 of the Food Regulations 1984 by omitting the items relating to ethylene dibromide and any combination of ethylene dibromide and methyl bromide.

The effect of these regulations is that ethylene dibromide and any combination of ethylene dibromide and methyl bromide will, until 1 January 1994, be permitted as incidental constituents in such foods and in such proportions as are specified in the second table to regulation 257 of the Food Regulations 1984.
