PURSUANT to the enactments specified in the third column of the Schedule to these regulations, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fees Regulations 1987.
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.
- 2. Amount of goods and services tax included—It is hereby declared that the fees fixed by the regulations, rules, and orders specified in the first column of the Schedule to these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1987, make it clear that the Court fees and other fees fixed by the regulations, rules, and orders specified in the Schedule to these regulations (all of which regulations, rules, and orders are administered in the Department of Justice) are inclusive of goods and services tax.
