



**THE FISHERIES (REPORTING) REGULATIONS 1990,  
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 26th day of August 1991

THE HON. D. C. MCKINNON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1991.

**2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in the definition of the term “landing”, after paragraph (a), the following paragraph:

“(aa) The removal of any vessel containing fish from New Zealand fisheries waters, for the purpose of moving the vessel to any place in New Zealand; or”.

**3. Method of entering certain details on return**—(1) Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (c), after the word “shell”, the words “, skirt, and gut”.

(2) Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (g), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(g) All times shall be recorded in hours and minutes according to a 24 hour clock in New Zealand standard time or New Zealand daylight time, whichever is for the time being applicable; and all dates shall be recorded in terms of the applicable time:”.

(3) Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(j) A reference in any return in respect of any landing to containers shall,—

“(i) Where the landing occurs upon the removal or discharge of fish from the vessel concerned, be read as a reference to the containers of fish so removed or discharged:

“(ii) Where the landing occurs upon the removal of the vessel concerned from New Zealand fisheries waters, be read as a reference to the containers of fish on the vessel.”

**4. Offences**—Regulation 25 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (1)(b) the word “completion”, and substituting the word “furnishing”:

(b) By omitting from subclause (4) the words “, knowing that statement or entry to be false or misleading or being reckless as to whether the statement or entry is false or misleading”.

**5. First Schedule amended**—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from note 4 (a) of the notes to form 1 the word “setting” where it secondly occurs, and substituting the word “hauling”:

(b) By omitting from form 4 the expression “NZST” where it occurs in the heading of the column for recording the time that each shot starts and ends:

(c) By revoking forms 5 and 6, and substituting the forms 5 and 6 set out in the First Schedule to these regulations.

**6. Second Schedule amended**—(1) Table 1 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the item relating to kahawai, and substituting in the first, third, and fourth columns, respectively, the expressions set out in Part I of the Second Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking Table 4 of Part I, and substituting the Table 4 set out in Part II of the Second Schedule to these regulations.

(3) Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting the words “*Dalatinus licha*” from the third column opposite the words “Black (seal) shark”, and substituting the words “*Scymnorhinus (Dalatias) licha*”:

- (b) By omitting from the third column opposite the words “Cardinal fish” the word “*telescopus*”, and substituting the expression “spp.”:
  - (c) By omitting from the second column opposite the item relating to “Flatfish” the expressions “BLF” and “GBL”, and substituting, respectively, the expressions “BFL” and “GFL”:
  - (d) By inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the items set out in Part III of the Second Schedule to these regulations.
- (4) Part V of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the fifth item (which relates to destination type code C), and substituting the items set out in Part IV of the Second Schedule to these regulations.
- (5) Part VIII of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the second column the expressions “S” and “CB”, and substituting, respectively, the expressions “St” and “Cb”.

**7. Transitional provision**—Notwithstanding regulation 5 (b) of these regulations, any unused trawl, catch, effort, and processing return in the form of form 4 set out in the First Schedule to the principal regulations (as specified before the commencement of these regulations) may hereafter be used for the purposes of the principal regulations, but shall be read as if the expression “NZST” were omitted.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1991, amend the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990.

*Regulation 2* extends the definition of the term "landing" in regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations to include the removal of a vessel from New Zealand fisheries waters for the purpose of moving the vessel to any place in New Zealand.

*Regulation 3* makes minor amendments to regulation 19 of the principal regulations, which relates to the method of entering certain details on a return. In particular, it is provided that New Zealand standard time or New Zealand daylight time shall be used, whichever is applicable.

*Regulation 4* removes the need for the prosecution to prove knowledge or recklessness on the part of an offender who is charged with making a false or misleading statement or entry on a return.

*Regulation 5* substitutes new forms 5 and 6 in the First Schedule to the principal regulations (the squid jigging catch effort return and the tuna longlining catch effort return).

*Regulation 6* makes various amendments to the codes specified in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations. In particular, a new table 4 (Kahawai area reference numbers) is substituted.
