THE FOREST REGULATIONS AMENDMENT, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Land Act, 1924. Date on which the regulations were made: 23rd day of December, 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 8th day of January, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Forest Regulations Amendment, 1936.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Forest Regulations under the Land Act, 1908, made on the 31st day of March, 1909* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of December, 1936.
- 4. Regulations amending the principal regulations made on the 14th day of February, 1917,† are revoked.
- 5. Clause 31 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted therefor:—
- "31. No timber shall be sold except at such price or at such rates as the Minister may determine."
- **6.** Clauses 46 and 47 of the principal regulations are hereby amended by deleting the word "royalty" wherever it occurs, and substituting therefor the words "purchase price".
