THE FOREST REGULATIONS AMENDMENT, 1936.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
 Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Land Act, 1924.
 Date on which the regulations were made : 23rd day of December, 1936.
 Date of notification in *Gazette* : 8th day of January, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Forest Regulations Amendment, 1936.
2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Forest Regulations under the Land Act, 1908, made on the 31st day of March, 1909* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").
3. These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of December, 1936.
4. Regulations amending the principal regulations made on the 14th day of February, 1917,† are revoked.
5. Clause 31 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted therefor :—
 "31. No timber shall be sold except at such price or at such rates as the Minister may determine."
6. Clauses 46 and 47 of the principal regulations are hereby amended by deleting the word "royalty" wherever it occurs, and substituting therefor the words "purchase price".
