Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 107G of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister of Fisheries, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Resource Rentals Variation) Order 1988.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1988.
- 2. Variation of resource rentals—The Fisheries Act 1983 is hereby amended by revoking Schedule 1B (as inserted by section 13 (4) of the Fisheries Amendment Act 1986 and substituted by clause 2 of the Fisheries (Resource Rentals Variation) Order 1987) and Schedule 1c (as inserted by section 28 (2) of that Act and as so substituted), and substituting the Schedules 1B and 1c set out in the Schedule to this order.
- **3. Revocation**—The Fisheries (Resource Rentals Variation) Order 1987* is hereby revoked.

Fisheries (Resource Rentals Variation) Order 1988

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order alters the annual resource rentals payable to the Crown under the Fisheries Act 1983 in respect of fish taken during the fishing year commencing 1 October 1988.

The resource rentals for blue moki, ling (sub-Antarctic area), red cod, silver warehou, and stargazer remain the same.

The resource rentals for flat fish, jack mackerel, orange roughy, oreo dories, rig, rock lobster, and school shark are increased by 5 percent.

The resource rentals for alfonsino, barracouta, hoki, tarakihi, and trevally are increased by 10 percent.

The resource rentals for squid are reduced by 37 percent for persons not having the use of foreign-owned fishing vessels, and increased by 5 percent for persons having the use of foreign-owned vessels.

The resource rentals for all other species are increased by 20 percent.
