THE FISHERIES (WETFISH, SHELLFISH, AND EEL FISHERIES) MORATORIUM NOTICE 1982

PURSUANT to section 119 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Wetfish, Shellfish, and Eel Fisheries) Moratorium Notice 1982.
 - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 19th day of March 1982.
 - 2. Interpretation—(1) In this notice—

"Designated New Zealand fisheries waters" means—

- (a) All waters in the exclusive economic zone of New Zealand which, pursuant to regulation 31 of the Exclusive Economic Zone (Foreign Fishing Craft) Regulations 1978*, are closed to trawling and bottom-lining by foreign fishing craft and which are specified in the Second Schedule to those regulations; and
- (b) All waters of the territorial sea of New Zealand (as defined by section 3 of the Territorial Sea and Exclusive Economic Zone Act 1977); and
- (c) All internal waters of New Zealand (as defined by section 4 of that Act); and
- (d) The waters of every lake, river, and stream where fish indigenous to New Zealand are found:
- "Eel" means the short-finned eel (Anquilla australis) and the long-finned eel (Anquilla dieffenbachii):
- "Shellfish" means—
 - (a) All species of the phylum Echinodermata and the phylum Mollusca; and
 - (b) All species of the class Crustacea; and
 - (c) All stages of the life history of all such shellfish;—

and includes mussels, oysters, paua, and scallops; but does not include squid (*Nototodarus sloanii*):

"Wetfish" means wetfish of the class Osteichthyes (fish) and the class Chondrichthyes (sharks, skates, rays, and elephant fish); but, except for southern bluefin tuna (Thunnus maccoyii) in Area G of

the New Zealand Fisheries Management Area described in the Third Schedule to the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1950†, does not include any species of tuna.

- (2) Words and expressions used in this notice and defined in Part I of the Fisheries Act 1908 have the meanings as so defined.
- 3. Moratorium imposed—No further licences, permissions, or fishing permits shall be granted or given under Part I of the Fisheries Act 1908 authorising the holder to take shellfish, wetfish, or eels in the designated New Zealand fisheries waters.
