ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery) Decontrolling Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 June 1997.

2. Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery to cease to be controlled fishery—It is declared that the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery ceases to be a controlled fishery on and from 1 June 1997.

Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery) Decontrolling Order 1997

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that the Foveaux Strait dredge oyster fishery will cease to be a controlled fishery on 1 June 1997. From that date it will become subject to an individual quota management regime (see the Fisheries (1997 Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Quota) Regulations 1997).
