PURSUANT to section 30 (6) (b) of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery) Decontrolling Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 June 1997.

**2. Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery to cease to be controlled fishery**—It is declared that the Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Fishery ceases to be a controlled fishery on and from 1 June 1997.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order provides that the Foveaux Strait dredge oyster fishery will cease to be a controlled fishery on 1 June 1997. From that date it will become subject to an individual quota management regime (see the Fisheries (1997 Foveaux Strait Dredge Oyster Quota) Regulations 1997).
