### THE FRIENDLY SOCIETIES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940.

# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this  $23\mathrm{rd}$  day of April, 1940.

### Present:

THE HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Friendly Societies Emergency Regulations 1940.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.
- 3. In these regulations "Registrar" means the Registrar of Friendly Societies under the Friendly Societies Act, 1909, and "society" and "branch" have the same meanings respectively as in that Act.
- 4. For the duration of the present war the Registrar may, if he thinks fit in his discretion, and subject to such conditions as he may impose, exempt any society or branch from the requirements of section 30 of the Friendly Societies Act, 1909, in respect of any rule or amendment of rule providing for the postponement or waiver of the whole or any part of any contribution payable by any member of the society or branch who is or hereafter becomes a member of any of the Naval, Military, or Air Forces of His Majesty raised in New Zealand for service overseas.
