

THE FISHERIES (SOUTHERN SCALLOP FISHERY ANNUAL ALLOWABLE CATCH) ORDER 1994

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 28ZL of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and application—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Annual Allowable Catch) Order 1994.
- (2) This order shall apply in respect of every southern scallop season commencing on or after the 10th day of August 1994.
- 2. Annual allowable catch reduced—Schedule 1D to the Fisheries Act 1983 (as inserted by section 23 of the Fisheries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1992) is hereby amended by omitting from Part III the expression "1100" (as substituted by clause 2 of the Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Annual Allowable Catch) Order 1993), and substituting the expression "850".

3. Revocation—The Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Annual Allowable Catch) Order 1993 (S.R. 1993/248) is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which applies to every southern scallop season commencing on or after 10 August 1994, reduces the annual allowable catch for the Southern Scallop fishery from 1100 tonnes to 850 tonnes.

The annual allowable catch is specified in Part III of Schedule 1b to the Fisheries Act 1983 and the order is authorised by section 28zL of that Act (as inserted by section 13 of the Fisheries Amendment Act (No. 2) 1992).
