ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of May 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 56 of the Fire Service Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Fire Service (Volunteer Fire Brigade Members' Gratuities) Order 1982.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1982.

**2. Gratuities on retirement or death of members of volunteer fire brigades**—Section 56 of the Fire Service Act 1975 is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subsection (1) and also from subsection (2) the expression "\$20", and substituting in each case the expression "\$40";

(b) By omitting from subsection (4) the expression "\$500", and substituting the expression "\$1,000".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order increases the amount of the gratuity that may be paid to a member of a volunteer fire brigade on his retirement or death from \$20 to \$40 for each year of service and also increases the maximum amount payable in respect of such gratuity from \$500 to \$1,000.
