Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 56 of the Fire Service Act 1975, His Excellency the
Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and
consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fire
Service (Volunteer Fire Brigade Members' Gratuities) Order 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1988.

**2. Gratuities on retirement or death of members of volunteer fire
brigades**—Section 56 of the Fire Service Act 1975 (as amended by clause 2
of the Fire Service (Volunteer Fire Brigade Members' Gratuities) Order
1982) is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subsection (1) and also from subsection (2) the
expression "\$40", and substituting in each case the expression
"\$80":

(b) By omitting from subsection (4) the expression "\$1,000", and
substituting the expression "\$2,000".

3. Revocation—The Fire Service (Volunteer Fire Brigade Members' Gratuities) Order 1982* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the amount of the gratuity that may be paid to a member of a volunteer fire brigade on his retirement or death from \$40 to \$80 for each year of service and also increases the maximum amount payable in respect of such gratuity from \$1,000 to \$2,000.
