



**THE FISHERIES (WHANGAREI SCALLOP FISHERY)
MORATORIUM NOTICE 1981**

PURSUANT to section 119 of the Fisheries Act 1908, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Whangarei Scallop Fishery) Moratorium Notice 1981.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—(1) In this notice, “Whangarei scallop fisheries” means those waters within New Zealand fisheries waters on the East Coast of the North Island between Cape Rodney and Cape Brett.

(2) Words and expressions used in this notice and defined in Part I of the Fisheries Act 1908 have the meanings as so defined.

3. Moratorium imposed—No further licences, permissions, or fishing permits shall be granted or given under Part I of the Fisheries Act 1908 authorising the holder to take scallops in the Whangarei scallop fishery.
