

FISHERIES (SOUTHERN SCALLOP FISHERY SEASON) NOTICE (NO. 2) 1999

PURSUANT to section 312 of the Fisheries Act 1996 and to an instrument of delegation signed by the Minister for Food, Fibre, Biosecurity and Border Control on 7 January 1999, the chief executive of the Ministry of Fisheries gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Season) Notice (No. 2) 1999.
- (2) This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice, "southern scallop fishery" means the Quota Management Area SCA7—Southern Scallop Fishery described in Part III of the First Schedule of the Fisheries Act 1996.
- **3. Southern scallop season for 1999/2000**—The southern scallop fishery season for the 1999/2000 fishing year begins on the date on which this notice comes into force and ends with the close of 14 February 2000.
- **4. Revocation**—The Fisheries (Southern Scallop Fishery Season) Notice 1999 (S.R. 1999/6) is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette, sets the southern scallop fishery season for the 1999/2000 fishing year. The new season begins on the commencement of this notice and ends with the close of 14 February 2000.
