



THE FIRE SERVICE LEVY NOTICE 1984

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Fire Service Act 1975, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fire Service Levy Notice 1984.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1984.

2. Rate of levy—The rate of the levy payable in respect of the amount for which any property is insured against fire under any contract of insurance made in New Zealand shall be—

(a) Where the period of the contract of insurance is one year, 2.0 cents for every \$100 of the amount for which the property is insured against fire:

(b) In the case of any other period, a pro rata proportion of the rate prescribed in paragraph (a) of this clause.

3. Repeal—The Fire Service Levy Notice 1982* is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice decreases the levy payable under the Fire Service Act 1975 on the amount insured under fire insurance policies from 3.5 cents to 2 cents for every \$100 of the amount so insured.
