**THE FIRE SERVICES REGULATIONS 1965,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of August 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fire Services Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Fire Services Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fire Services Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking clause (1) of the First Schedule, and substituting the following clause:

“(1) The attendance charges authorised to be charged by any Urban Fire Authority under regulations 9, 12 (3), and 13 (2) hereof shall be as follows:

Charge for crew (subject to clause (3) of this Schedule)	A charge for crew costs, if any, calculated at the hourly rate normally payable by the Urban Fire Authority for fire duty.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the charges which may be made by an Urban Fire Authority for brigade attendances outside its district.
