Pursuant to the Fire Service Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fire Services Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fire Services Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Form of return of premium income—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking—
 - (a) Regulation 13A (as inserted by regulation 2 (1) of the Fire Services Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 2):
 - (b) The Third Schedule thereto (as added by regulation 2 (2) of the Fire Services Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 2).
- (2) The Fire Services Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 2, are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment revokes the provision requiring a mandatory form of return by insurance companies in respect of their premium income.
