PURSUANT to sections 175 and 360 (2) of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Fisheries, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Porangahau Taiapure) Order 1996.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Porangahau taiapure constituted—The New Zealand fisheries waters (being estuarine or littoral coastal waters) described in the Schedule to this order are hereby declared to be a taiapure-local fishery.

SCHEDULE

PORANGAHAU TAIAPURE

All that area of New Zealand fisheries waters enclosed by a line commencing at the eastern-most point of Cape Turnagain (at 40° 29.4'S and 176° 37.4'E) and proceeding along a straight line (bearing 025° T) to 40° 26.7'S and 176° 39.1'E, and the continuing in a generally northerly direction at a distance of one nautical mile from the shoreline (the mean high-water mark) to 40° 14.2'S and 176° 47.0'E, and then proceeding in a straight line (bearing 025° T) to the mouth of an unnamed stream north of Blackhead Point at 40° 11.7'S and 176° 48.5'E.
