### Regulations

- 1 Title**  
These regulations are the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Amendment Regulations 2006.

**2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2006.

**3 Principal regulations amended**

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Regulations 1993.

**4 Vessels required to carry and operate automatic location communicators**

Regulation 3(1) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (e):

“(ea) New Zealand fishing vessels of 28 metres or less in length that are used at any time during a fishing year in fishing for deepwater clam; and”.

**Explanatory note**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 2006, amend the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Regulations 1993.

The amendment requires automatic location communicators to be carried by vessels used to fish for deepwater clam.
