



**THE GAME (PACKING AND EXPORT) REGULATIONS 1967,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Game (Packing and Export) Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Game (Packing and Export) Regulations 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1973.

2. Fees for inspection of game packing houses—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 73, and substituting the following regulation:

“73. There shall be payable in respect of game packaged or processed in any game packing house the following fees for the inspection of the premises and the products packed or processed therein:

For every carcass of deer	30 cents
For every portion of carcass of deer as prescribed in the first proviso to regulation 46 of these regulations	30 cents
For every carcass of goat	7.5 cents
For every carcass of pig	20 cents
For every container of hares (not more than 6 hares to the container)	12.5 cents”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe a new scale of fees, effective from 1 May 1973, for the inspection of game packing houses and the products packed or processed therein.
