Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Gaming and Lotteries (Licence Fees) Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the Gaming and Lotteries (Licence Fees) Regulations 1997¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 30 September 2001.

3 Schedule amended

Paragraph 5 of the Schedule of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “200”, and substituting the expression “254”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations come into force on 30 September 2001. They increase the fee payable for a licence issued or renewed under section 8 of the Gaming and Lotteries Act 1977 to authorise a society to conduct any game by means of 1 or more gaming machines. The fee is increased from \$200 to \$254 for each gaming machine.
