PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Golden Bay County Foreshore Licence Order 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Golden Bay County Foreshore Licence Order 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from the part thereof relating to wharfage the words "Timber, sawn, per 100 ft with right to remain on wharf two weeks 0 3", and substituting the words "Timber, sawn, per 100 ft with right to remain on wharf two weeks 0 6".
