PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Great Barrier Island Foreshore Licence Order 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Great Barrier Island Foreshore Licence Order 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. First Schedule to principal order amended—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words "and 13320, respectively", and substituting the words "13320, and 14351".
- 3. New Second Schedule to principal order substituted—The principal order is hereby further amended by revoking the Second Schedule thereto, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule hereto.

"Separate consignments of goods shall be computed separately, and, notwithstanding that they may be landed or shipped by a single person or firm, shall not be computed in the aggregate, except that when any person or firm lands or ships more than 1 package of goods on any 1 day by the same ship, wharf dues shall be computed on those packages in the aggregate and not separately.

"All dues shall be paid before goods are shipped or delivered.

"All goods conveyed as the contents of any vehicle landed on the wharf shall be deemed to have been landed on the wharf independently of the vehicle and be subject to dues accordingly."

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Great Barrier Island Foreshore Licence Order 1969, principally by substituting a new Schedule of wharf dues. The wharf dues payable at Whangaparapara Harbour, Okupu Harbour, and Tryphena Harbour under the principal order as amended are now uniform with wharf dues payable at Port Fitzroy under the Port Fitzroy Foreshore Licence Order 1969 (S.R. 1969/239) as amended by the Port Fitzroy Foreshore Licence Order 1969, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1972/82).
