THE GEOTHERMAL ENERGY REGULATIONS 1961,
AMENDMENT NO. 1

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Geothermal Energy Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric conversions—(1) Regulation 28 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “200 ft”, and substituting the expression “61 metres”.

(2) Regulation 30 (7) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “200 ft”, and substituting the expression “61 metres”.

(3) Regulation 32 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “one-quarter of a mile”, and substituting the expression “400 metres”.
