ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Geothermal Energy Act 1953 and the Ministry of Energy Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.

2. Applications for authorities and licences—(1) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) (as amended by regulation 4 (2) of the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following subclause:

*S.R. 1961/124 Amendment No. 1: S.R. 1975/97 Amendment No. 2: S.R. 1987/78 Amendment No. 3: S.R. 1987/99 Amendment No. 4: S.R. 1987/157 "(2) Every application for an authority shall be accompanied by an application fee of \$41, and every application for a licence by a licence fee of \$102.30 (both such fees being inclusive of goods and services tax at the rate of 12.5 percent payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985). If a licence is not granted the applicant shall be entitled to a refund of \$61.40 (inclusive of any amount representing goods and services tax paid)."

(2) Regulation 4 (2) of the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 2 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1989, set the fees payable under the Geothermal Energy Regulations 1961 at a figure that is inclusive of goods and services tax at the new rate of 12.5 percent.
