ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 241 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1981.
- 2. Testing and Inspection fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the new Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 3. Revocation—The General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 5 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute a new scale of testing, inspection, and design approval fees for cargo containers and mechanical cargo handling equipment. The fees are increased by 15 percent.
