## ORDER IN COUNCIL

### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 241 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1986.
- 2. Design approval, testing, and inspection fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as

substituted by regulation 4 of the General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**3. Consequential revocations**—The General Harbour (Ship, Cargo, and Dock Safety) Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 7 are hereby amended by revoking clause 4 and the Schedule.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 August 1986, substitute a new scale of testing, inspection, and design approval fees for cargo containers and mechanical cargo handling equipment.
