ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 28th day of March 1978

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1935\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1978.

**2. Sixth Schedule**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Sixth Schedule (as amended by regulation 6 of the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the new Sixth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1935, Amendment No. 5 are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6.

INSPECTION AND TESTING FEES

Gear and Appliances	Fees
1. For the examination of plans of cargo gear for the purpose of prescribing the safe working load thereof:	\$15 per hour or part thereof.
2. For the inspection (other than the annual inspection) and testing of any cargo tray, or similar appliance provided with permanent lifting attachments	\$15 per hour or part thereof.
3. For the inspection (other than the annual inspection) and testing of any other item of cargo gear	\$15 per hour or part thereof.
4. Annual inspection of cargo gear other than an inspection of cargo gear belonging to a ship carried out in conjunction with a survey for a certificate of survey issued pursuant to section 213 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952	\$15 per hour or part thereof."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations revise the inspection and testing fees in respect of cargo gear.
