ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 21st day of July 1986

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 241 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the
Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and
consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1986.

2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 23, and substituting the following regulation:

“23. The owner of any cargo gear that is inspected or examined or tested, or the design of which is submitted for approval, under these regulations, shall pay the appropriate fee specified in the Third Schedule to

these regulations in respect of work carried out by a Surveyor or a Port Safety Inspector in performing any such service.

3. New Third Schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule, and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

FEEES

For attendance of a Surveyor or Port Safety Inspector for the inspection, examination, or testing of any cargo gear in accordance with the requirements of these regulations, excluding the inspection of ship's cargo gear carried out in conjunction with a survey for the issue of a certificate of survey pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952:

| For all necessary work done where approval of the design of any cargo gear is sought under regulation 6 of these regulations | \$65 per hour or part of an hour.” |

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 August 1986, increase the fees payable under the General Harbour (Safe Working Load) Regulations 1982.
