Pursuant to the Gas Industry Act 1958 and the Royal Powers Act 1953, Her Majesty the Queen, acting by and with the advice and consent of Her Executive Council, is pleased to make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Gas Industry Regulations 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Gas Industry Regulations 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Revocation—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Gas Industry Regulations 1960 to enable the owners of gas undertakings to charge consumers according to the number of British thermal units which the gas is capable of producing.
