PURSUANT to the Gas Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Gas Industry Regulations 1984, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Gas Industry Regulations 1984* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Second Schedule—The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking item 3 of Part II, and substituting the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Gas Industry Regulations 1984 to make it clear that the fee of \$200 plus \$20 an hour applies only to field testing for type approval of online C.N.G. meters, and the fee for the routine accuracy testing and stamping is to be \$12.
