THE GAS-PRODUCER MANUFACTURE CONTROL NOTICE 1940.

PURSUANT to Regulation 2 of the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1,* the Minister of Supply doth hereby declare as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Gas-producer Manufacture Control Notice 1940.

2. The gas-producer manufacturing industry, as hereinafter defined, is a controlled industry for the purpose of the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939.†

3. For the purpose of this notice the gas-producer manufacturing industry shall be deemed to include the manufacture of gas-producer units for use on motor-vehicles or in connection with stationary internal-combustion engines, and the assembling of the parts of any such units.
