THE GAS METER TESTING FEES DETERMINATION 1981

Pursuant to regulation 16A of the Gas Industry Regulations 1978, the Gas Referees for the purposes of those regulations, after consultation with the Chief Inspector of Weights and Measures, hereby make the following determination.

DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Gas Meter Testing Fees Determination 1981.
- (2) This determination shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Examination and testing fees—The fees payable to Meter Inspectors by the owners of gas undertakings and assemblers and repairers of gas meters in respect of the examination and testing of gas meters by Meter Inspectors shall be those set out in the Schedule to this determination.

⁽¹⁾ The examination and testing fee shall be payable even though the meter is rejected for a fault disclosed during the examination or test.

⁽²⁾ The minimum examination and testing fee payable by any person on each occasion on which that person produces a meter or meters for examination and testing shall be \$6.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination fixes the fees payable for the examination and testing of gas meters by Meter Inspectors.
