The Gas Industry Company Limited is approved to be an industry body for the purposes of Part 4A of the Gas Act 1992.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, approves the Gas Industry Company Limited to be an industry body for the purposes of Part 4A of the Gas Act 1992 (which relates to the governance of the gas industry). Subpart 2 of that Part provides for the co-regulation of the gas industry by the Government and an industry body.
