**THE GRADING OF PRIMARY-SCHOOL TEACHERS
REGULATIONS 1947**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Present :

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations shall be cited as the Grading of Primary-school Teachers Regulations 1947.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day following publication of a notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the regulations relating to the grading of primary-school teachers made under the Education Act, 1914, by Order in Council dated the 30th day of March, 1926,* the general grading to be made pursuant to those regulations in the year 1947 shall be made for the years 1947 and 1948, and no general grading shall be made in the year 1948.

(2) In the grading made in the year 1947 marks shall be assigned to cover both years, and the aggregate marks assigned to any teacher for efficiency shall be allotted in accordance with the following provisions, namely :—

(a) In the absence of special circumstances, one-half of the aggregate marks so assigned shall be allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1947, and the residue of the marks shall be allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1948. For the purposes of this paragraph, if the aggregate of the marks so assigned is not an even number, the number of marks allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1947, shall be one-half of the next highest number :

(b) In special circumstances, and for the purpose of avoiding anomalies or hardship, the Director may, in his discretion, allot the aggregate marks so assigned to any teacher as follows :—

(i) All the marks so assigned to the teacher may be allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1947 ; or

(ii) Any number or proportion of those marks may be allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1947, and the residue allotted as at the 1st day of January, 1948.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in clause 18 of the regulations referred to in subclause (1) hereof, it shall not be necessary to publish a general graded list of teachers for the year 1947 or the year 1948.
