PURSUANT to sections 61 and 83 of the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Game Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Game Regulations 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1978.

**2. Game inspection fees abolished**—(1) Regulation 149 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Game Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1) is hereby revoked.

(2) Regulation 2 of the Game Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially revoked.

These regulations abolish, on 1 October 1978, inspection fees payable to the Crown in respect of game.
